UK Forks Privacy & Cookies Policy

UK Forks is a trading Division of Vp PLC a company incorporated in England, and is a member of the Vp Plc Group ("the Group"). The Group ("we", "us") includes UK Forks, Groundforce, Airpac Bukom Oilfield Services, Hire Station Limited, TPA Portable Roadways Limited, Torrent Trackside Limited, and their associated companies from time to time. A full list of companies is available upon request (see 'contact us' below).

The purpose of this statement is to set out how we use personal information that we may obtain about you. Personal information means information relating to a living individual who can be identified from that information or from that information and other information that is held by or is likely to be held by us. It is our policy to take all necessary steps to ensure that personal data held by us is processed fairly and lawfully. We will take all necessary steps to implement this policy. All our employees and data processors who have access to personal data are obliged to respect the confidentiality of your personal data. Furthermore it is our policy to ensure that, when dealing with personal data all relevant statutory requirements are complied with, including the eight Data Protection Principles contained in the Data Protection Act and to monitor our procedures periodically to ensure compliance. Personal data may be transferred to countries outside of the European Economic Area. In using the services you consent to such a transfer.

By either registering as a user of any services provided by Vp PLC on this website and by using the Vp PLC website generally you agree to our use of personal information.

Use of your Personal Information

1. When you register and use this site:

You will be asked to provide certain information such as your contact details. We will store this data and hold it on computers or otherwise. We will use this data to fulfil our agreement with you.

2 We may use information that you provide or that is obtained by us:

(a) to register you with our website and to administer our website services;
(b) To fulfil our agreement with you and processing and obtaining payment.
(c) To analyse and profile your shopping preferences e.g. (market, customer and product analysis) to enable us to review, develop and improve the products and services we offer and to enable us to provide you and other customers with relevant information through our marketing programme. We may use your information to make decisions about you using computerised technology, for example automatically selecting products and services which we think will interest you from the information we have. We may keep you informed of such products and services including special offers, discounts, offers, competitions and so on by any of the following methods:

- Email
- Telephone (including automated calls)
- SMS text messages and other electronic messages such as picture messaging
- Post
- Fax
- Or otherwise

(including products and services of other companies and organisations) which we consider may be of interest to you. When you provide us with your information you will be given the opportunity to say if you do not wish to receive information of such products and services from either us or carefully chosen third parties

(d) To administer any prize draws or competitions you may enter.

3. We may supplement the information that you provide to us with information that we receive from third parties.

Fraud Prevention

4. In order to protect our customers and us from fraud and theft, we may pass on information that we obtain from making identity checks and other information in our customer records, including how you conduct your account, to other Group companies and to financial and other organisations (including law enforcement agencies) involved in fraud prevention and detection, to use in the same way.

Telephone Calls

5. Calls may be recorded to verify content and may be used together with your customer records for regulatory compliance, quality control and staff training, preventing or detecting criminal activity and for complaint resolution.

Disclosure of Your Information

6. We may give information about you to companies and organisations whose products we provide to you, e.g. services as follows:

- (a) To other companies and organisations to administer any prize draws or competitions.
- (b) To our agents, staff and approved third parties to carry out services for us.
- (c) To anyone to whom we transfer our rights and duties under our agreement with you.
- (d) If we have a duty to do so or if the law allows us to do so.

Cookies
